Itinerary as follows:

9am – 10am Sign In

This will be done in the triangle gate office at the main entrance of the racetrack

10am – 11am Open Testing – Long Hairpin

Run as an open pit lane, drivers will be able to enter/exit the track as they wish. The circuit will be setup as the standard track layout

11am – 12pm Open Testing – Short Hairpin

Run as an open pit lane, drivers will be able to enter/exit the track as they wish. The circuit will be setup with a shorter track layout

12pm – 12:30pm Break

12:30pm Qualifying

Long Hairpin – 10 mins

12:50pm Heat 1

Long Hairpin – 10 mins

1:10pm Heat 2

Short Hairpin – 10 mins

1:30pm Heat 3

Long Hairpin – 10 mins

1:50pm Heat 4

Short Hairpin – 10 mins

2:20pm Final

Long Hairpin – 12 mins

2:30pm – 3pm Open Testing
