LONDON CUP PARKING AND PITTING

Setup times:

Competitors will be given access to arrive & setup:

Wednesday 30th October - 4pm until 8pm

Thursday 31st October – 8am until 8pm

Friday 1st November – 8am until 8pm


Saturday 2nd November – 7am

Setting up prior to these times **MUST** be arranged by appointment on 01992 460895.

On arrival:

From Thursday 31st October, competitor vehicle passes **MUST** be visible from the front windscreen on arrival and displayed at all times until the end of the weekend.

Solo competitors: Privateer competitor vehicle passes will be issued by email prior to 30th October.



Team competitors: Should they need to, any competitor racing with a team will be issued a temporary 30 minute drop off pass on arrival. After your 30 minute allowance you **MUST** park in our spectator car park. This will incur a small fee.

Caravans/Motorhomes/RV's:

The circuit has designated a parking area for competitors who wish to sleep in Caravans, Motorhomes & RV's.

Solo competitors: MUST setup and run from their accommodation vehicle. Please do not park here and setup an awning somewhere else.

Team competitors: Team competitors who wish to bring a caravan, motorhomes or RV to sleep in **MUST** call the circuit in advance to arrange offsite parking on 01992 460895.

Joint privateer competitors: If you are not running in a team but you are sharing awning space with other competitors, the circuit will allow you to park wherever your joint awning is situated subject to space available. If your accommodation vehicle is not needed for race support, you **MUST** call the

circuit in advance to arrange offsite parking on 01992 460895.

Please note, Rye House does not have any campsite facilities i.e. electric hook-ups, waste disposal etc.

Setting up:


When setting up around the race track – The competitor zone:

Solo competitors are permitted to park one vehicle & erect one awning.

Teams are permitted to park one support vehicle & their necessary awnings. Please note, we will not permit additional vehicles to park within the competitor zone.

Please be mindful when setting up:

- **Please use common sense.** Do not setup in the middle of the paddock with no one around you. Ensure you setup as close as possible to someone else.
- Ensure there is a clear route past your vehicle & awning to allow other competitors & emergency vehicles to pass.



Please note, you will be asked to move if deemed necessary by a member of staff. **If you are unsure, simply ask before you setup.**

Spectator Parking:

We are unable to park **ANY** spectator vehicles around the circuit or within the paddock area. The London Cup is notoriously busy and we are well aware that “it is a squeeze”. Therefore, we will have parking officials directing you to park in a designated spectator zone. This will incur a small fee.

THESE INSTRUCTIONS ARE TO ENSURE ALL COMPETITORS CAN SETUP EFFICIENTLY & THE RACE MEETING RUNS SMOOTHLY.

OUR GOAL IS TO PROVIDE A SAFE & ENJOYABLE RACING EVENT & WE ASK ALL COMPETITORS TO RESPECT OUR EFFORTS TO FACILITATE EVERYONE.

IT IS NOT OUR AIM TO PENALISE YOU.

RYE HOUSE WILL NOT PERMIT TEAMS OR COMPETITORS TO RACE SHOULD THEY FAIL TO FOLLOW OUR INSTRUCTIONS.
